Round Robin to Dartmouth and Totnes

This full day trip takes you to two of the most beautiful and interesting places in South Devon. First, catch the steam train to Dartmouth, at the mouth of the River Dart, which is rich in maritime history and home to the famous Britannia Royal Naval College. After some time here, catch the ferry from Dartmouth upriver to the traditional market town of Totnes, with beautiful traditional buildings and a fascinating history and culture. Finally catch the bus from Totnes back to Torquay. Depending on tide times, this journey can also be done in reverse.

Steam Train to Agatha Christie's House

Agatha Christie was born in Torquay in 1890. She grew up here and came back to live at Greenway House near Torquay when she was older. Greenway House is now a museum to her life surrounded by beautiful gardens with stunning views over the surrounding countryside and River Dart. You can reach Greenway by Steam Train from Paignton Train Station, or JP runs regular trips to Greenway as part of our Social Programme.
