

## Teacher Refresher Course CLIL - TR111-CLIL

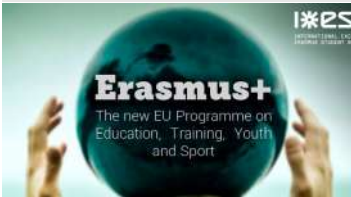
**Course Aim:** A two week course for subject teachers aimed at exploring the principles behind Content and Language Integrated Learning and improving participants' English language skills.
